He was educated at Rugby and at Armagh College and entered the Army at the age of 18 as an Ensign in the 69th Regiment. While that Regiment was stationed in Barbados in 1857, he married the youngest daughter of Governor Hincks, of whose family he has since been a member. He has been Aid de Camp and Privat Secretary and filled the latter office at the time of his fatal accident, which caused his death. He retired from the Army in 1862, having attained the rank of Captain, and soon after accepted the office of Captain and Adjutantof the Georgetown Malitia. Captain Beresford's untimely death has been most severely felt. He had succeeded in attaching to him by strong ties of friendship a very large circle of friends, while those with whom he was more nearly connected, have sustained an irreparable loss - Communicated.
