Whilst yet but a very young man, Mr. Steele held a commission in the Militia of Trinidad and subsequently in that of this island. He was a faithful friend and good citizen, unassuming in his manners, and strong in his integrity. His mortal remains, followed by a large number of his sorrowing relatives and friends, were conveyed to their last resting place at Greenhill, and were lain by the side of his father, on the afternoon of Friday the 29th instant - The Grenada Phoenix.
